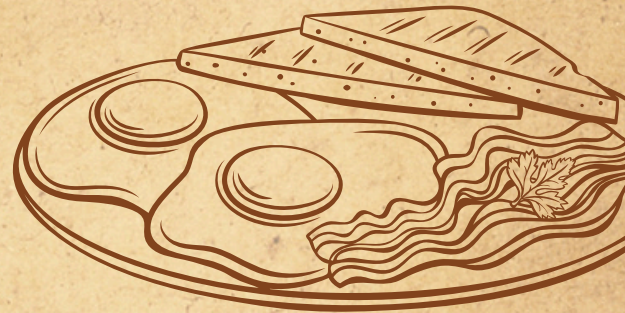

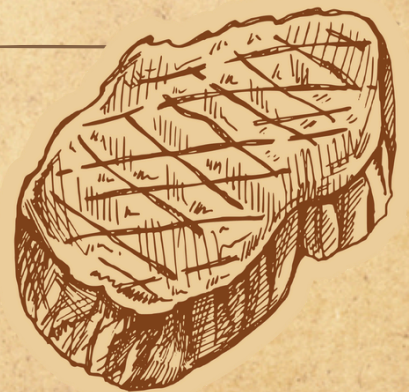

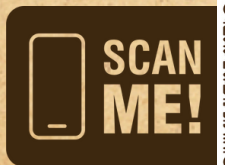

# History of Toeka

Where Toeka se Dae stands today, absolutely nothing happened in 1930, and even less in the 1940s, '50s, '60s, '70s, and '80s! In the late '90s, the farmer on the property was producing too many vegetables and too much milk for the local market, and decided to open a small stall to get rid of the surplus.

It went extremely well, and the little farm stall grew from strength to strength. The farmer soon realised that his customers wanted much more than the small variety of stock he had to offer, so he made the shop bigger and started selling meat as well. Bread followed, then rusks and other baked goods from local "boere tannies." Soon enough, the farm stall was once again too small!

He revamped the building, doubling its size, only to discover a year later that it was too small again! A bottle store followed, along with a butchery, bakery, and coffee shop in 2012. That also became too small, and once again we had to break down and rebuild to become what we are today.

"Toeka se Dae," as it is known today, is a gathering place for locals as well as people from surrounding towns and cities. Here, they can find the latest meat, drinks, biscuits, biltong, soft drinks, bread, butter, jam, or gifts needed for the weekend, holidays, or the long road ahead.
